









COMMENTARY

The national offering was 6,500 bales less than last week, but the demand signals seen a fortnight ago have started to waiver. A 5 cent decline in the Northern region indicator on Tuesday was followed up with a further 6 cent loss on Wednesday. The 20 micron indicator and Merino cardings managed small gains with the balance falling 15 to 38 cents over the course of the week. This week's closing level is almost like looking in a mirror when comparing prices of the corresponding time last season. Very little has changed over the past 12 months as can be seen on the Northern region indicator chart below. 31,695 bales were sold nationally for the week with a passed in rate of 8%. Major buyers included Techwool, PJ Morris and Tianyu with the buying pattern remaining evenly spread. Up until the end of last week 97,000 fewer bales had been sold for the season this is broadly in line with AWTA testing statistics that is showing a similar decline in the number of bales tested. The previous two seasons we have witnessed an uptrend close to this point in time as we head towards the annual three week Christmas recess.
